ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to prepare the City's response to the ENF outlining the City's concerns and, specifically, to request a full Environmental Impact Report, which takes the long-term view and does not allow segmentation of the project, takes into account impact of wetlands and looks at improved public transportation, and furthermore, that it might request withdrawal of the ENF and submit this to the City Council for review by Monday, May 15, 1989, prior to submittal to the State on May 18th.
