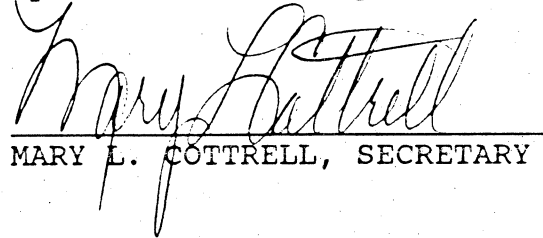

On October 20, 1992, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") opened an investigation into the appropriate ratemaking treatment for vehicular compressed natural gas ("CNG") offered by local distribution companies within the Commonwealth and the specific proposal made by Bay State Gas Company to offer CNG at a subsidized rate. This investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on into own motion into the proper rate for compressed natural gas offered by local distribution companies within the Commonwealth; and Rate CNG, and associated cost recovery, as proposed by Bay State Gas Company.
