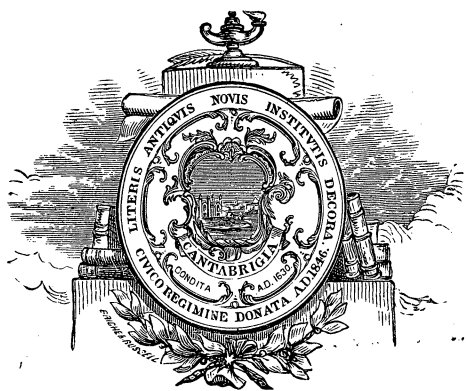




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 7 1889.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Donnell Street, so called between Concord Avenue and Garden Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty feet*, in width between *Concord Avenue and Garden Street*,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason and Son, Surveyors, dated July 8th, 1884.*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *as* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, the several owners of abutting lands having waived the usual notice, and signed an agreement to claim no damages on account of such taking and laying out,

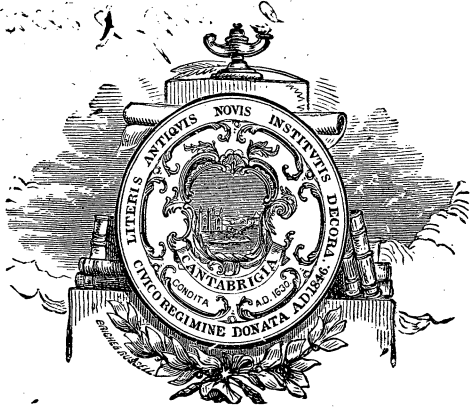

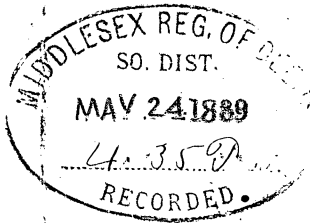
