IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

June 19th, 1894.

Ordered,

Whereas, by a resolve and order approved April 25, 1894, certain parcels of land, therein described, were taken on (Norton street,) and the same were laid out as a public street or way of the City of Cambridge, it is therefore Ordered,

That due notice be given to (Fannie G. Black, Heirs of John A. Whipple, Michael O'Sullivan, John Barnes, Michael F. Tracy, Walter Bla, Trustee, Mary C. Tolman, John Cotter, Smith Gerrish,) and all other persons interested as owners, proprietors, tenants, occupants, or otherwise, in said land, that they cut off, pull down, remove, and carry away all buildings, erections, and obstructions of every sort standing on and projecting over the lines of (said Norton street,) as established by the resolve and order aforesaid, or move and set back the same to the said lines, and vacate and surrender the land and premises taken as aforesaid, on or before the fifth day of July now next ensuing.

And in default thereof, the City of Cambridge will forthwith enter upon said land, and cause all buildings, erections and obstructions standing on and projecting over the lines of said (Norton) street, as established by the resolve and order aforesaid, to be cut off, pulled down, removed and carried away, or sold in such manner as said board shall deem expedient, or to be moved and set back to said line, and the land to be vacated and surrendered to said city.
