WHEREAS:

It has come to the attention of this City Council, through the newspaper media, that the operation of barrel rolling and separate garbage collection as it has been known in the past, has been stopped, and

WHEREAS:

The residents of the City of Cambridge have for many years enjoyed this method of garbage collection and barrel rolling, and

WHEREAS:

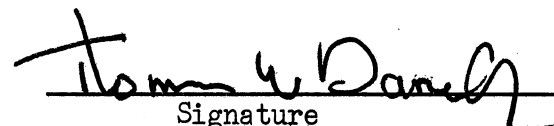
A majority of this City Council, on September 15, 1975, voted their opposition to any change in the methods of garbage collection and barrel rolling, and
