ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to have the Council on Aging to work with the Cambridge Housing Authority and Arts Groups (CMAC, Dance Complex, Dance Umbrella etc.), regarding providing monthly (or weekly) traveling arts presentations which travel from the Senior Centers to Senior Housing Development common rooms.

ORDERED: That many CHA elderly tenants have yet to embrace the senior centers, and it is hoped that by providing regularly, high quality entertainment, more seniors will enjoy city benefits and engage in further senior activities either in their building or at the citywide center or at the 2050 Massachusetts Avenue center.
