of **Robert A. Cawley** at this time of such personal loss; and be it further

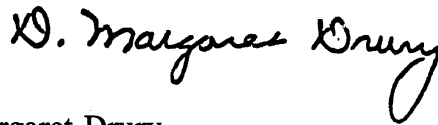
