The undersigned - Owners & Residents and Abutters, petition ^{you} body to accept, lay out and grade, Harvey street situate in N. Cambridge - the said street is not only a disgrace to the City, an annoyance to the inhabitants, but also a source of danger from Epidemics. We would further humbly call your attention to the fact that for a long time past and at present the above named Harvey St., is almost ^{entirely} used in the interests of the Boston and Maine Railroad Corporation in their freighting business, the said Corporation causing number of trains to be discharged as well loaded, by the west end st Railroad and other Companies, as well as private firms, whose teams cut up the street to such an extent as to make it dangerous both for travel and health. We therefore present this petition, trusting that your board may find some means of relieving the petitioners of the above nuisance and we will ever pray &c, &c,
