Pursuant to the inquiry by Councillor Alfred Vellucci, please be advised I am forwarding for your review a copy of the order relative to the naming of "Galileo Galilei Way" along with a copy of the distribution list of said order. This, as are all other orders, was forwarded in accordance with the rules of the City Council and transmitted within thirty-six hours of the end of the meeting. I hope this will resolve any questions the Council may have relative to this issue.

With regard to the alternative towing procedures which were the subject of a hearing before the City Council on October 29, 1984, this office has been informed by the Director of Traffic and Parking that he is studying the proposals. At the suggestion of the City Clerk, the petitioner presented, in detail, copies of his proposal to the City Councillors and the Traffic Director at the hearing, with a further suggestion that he stress the possibility of a pilot program in designated areas of the City where congestion and the pressure of other parked cars would not hinder the street cleaning program.

I trust that the above will be helpful in bringing the Council membership up to date on these matters.
