IN CITY COUNCIL

November 24, 1975

WHEREAS:

Jerome J. O'Connell, a former employee of the Recreation Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Recreation Department on March 31, 1952 and was pensioned on March 6, 1974 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 6 of the General Laws and died on September 9, 1975, having served not less than thirty-one years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee has no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Catherine Ryan O'Connell, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Jerome J. O'Connell, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Catherine Ryan O'Connell, widow of Jerome J. O'Connell, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
