WHEREAS: Complaints about the residue of ice and snow on the sidewalks from the storm of the closing days of February in the Upland Road/Massachusetts Avenue area raise the question as to the consistent enforcement efforts made by city departments to insure full citizen compliance across the city with Cambridge Municipal Code 12.16.110B which states:

" Removal of Ice from Sidewalks

The owner or occupant of private property bordering on a street where there is a sidewalk or footway any portion of which is encumbered by ice shall within 6 hours after the sidewalk or footway becomes encumbered with ice cause such sidewalk or footway to be made safe and convenient by removing the ice therefrom, or by keeping the same covered with sand or some other suitable substance " ; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager obtain from appropriate city departments all data which will show or fail to show that ice-on-the-sidewalk scofflaws are not being winked at and that enforcement of this Ordinance, by citation if need be, has priority status in assuring the health and safety of the walking public in the City of Cambridge; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the Council with specifics on this matter by April 3, 1989.
