- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Police Chief, Fire Chief, Director of Traffic and Parking, License Commission and the Public Works Commissioner to make the appropriate arrangements to allow John F. Kennedy Street to be closed between Mt. Auburn Street and Harvard Square on Sunday, October 10, 1982 in order for the Harvard Square Businessmen to participate in the "Octoberfest"; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Chief of Police be and hereby is authorized to issue a permit for the sale of food, beverages and merchandise so that the Business Association can comply with the Massachusetts on the requested date; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the License Commission be and hereby is authorized to issue a license to sell wine and malt beverages by the cup; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to issue a sidewalk sales permit; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Health Department be and hereby is requested to issue to issue a permit for the sale of food and beverages outdoors.

Provided that, before erecting the above named ~~sign~~ banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

Dear Mr. Mayor and Members of the City Council:

For the fourth year in a row, the Harvard Square Business Association is sponsoring an "Oktoberfest" in Harvard Square.

The Oktoberfest will take place on Columbus Day weekend. It is scheduled for Sunday, October 10th, with a raindate to Monday, October 11th. If the weather should prove too inclement on Columbus Day weekend, we have scheduled an additional raindate of Sunday, October 17th.

The Harvard Square Business Association would be pleased to have the Members of the City Council attend the Oktoberfest. In addition, we request you to assist us in organizing the event by directing the following department heads to issue the various permits and licenses required to hold the event on October 10th and as it may be raindated: namely,

1) the Chief of Police to issue a permit for the sale of food, beverages, and merchandise, so that the Business Association can comply with the Massachusetts laws governing the observance of Sundays and holidays;

2) the Director of Traffic and Parking to permit the closing of John F. Kennedy Street between Mt. Auburn Street and Harvard Square and, in his discretion, to close part of Brattle Street and/or John F. Kennedy Street further toward the Charles River, should it seem desirable to have more space;

3) the License Commission to issue a license to sell wine and malt beverages by the cup;

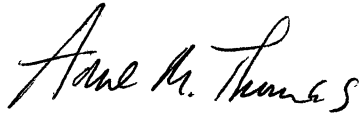
4) the Commissioner of Public Works to issue a sidewalk sales permit;

5) the Cambridge Health Department to permit the sale of food and beverages outdoors; and

6) the above and any other department heads not yet named to issue any permits or licenses omitted in this request.

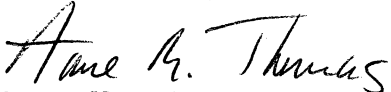
