- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Lewis G. Wiggins, late Comptroller and Vice-President for Administrative Affairs for Harvard University; and
- WHEREAS: Lewis, a graduate of Columbia University, was named Comptroller of Harvard University in 1954, working diligently to see the University through the difficult period of the 1960's and 70's under the tenure of then President Nathan Pusey; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Wiggins, in his capacity as Vice-President for Administrative Affairs directed the University's building program, often overcoming opposition from city officials, a position which caused him to be called before the City Council in 1967 to defend Harvard's property holdings; and
- WHEREAS: Lewis was a former Secretary and Treasurer of the Chilcott Laboratory, Inc., as well as a former Director of Bay Banks, Treasurer of the Mid-Cambridge Corporation and a former Vice-President of Emerson Hospital; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mary Wiggins and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Wiggins on behalf of the entire City Council.

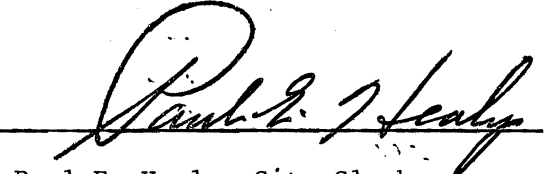
