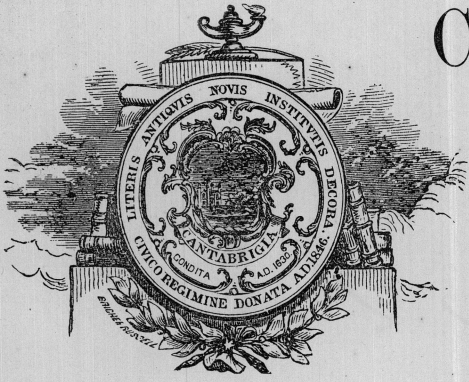

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

J. G. Chase City Engineer
dated Nov. 22nd 1872

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the removal
of fences and other property standing ~~on~~ thereon,
