IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Frank G. Matos of the Committee for the Celebration of 'Day of Portugal' for the erection of a banner over Cambridge Street by the Harrington School in East Cambridge; said banner extending from the light pole at the corner of Harding Street to a large tree in front of the Harrington School, from Friday, May 25, 1984 to June 4, 1984.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
