To All Municipal Officials:

I am pleased to inform you that the estimated receipts from the Lottery distribution for FY87 have been increased from the \$170 million listed on the FY87 Cherry Sheets to \$195 million. Your City or Town's share is listed on the attached page.

You may consider this letter as an authorization to appropriate from this additional amount the funds necessary to cover any overruns in your snow and ice removal accounts resulting from the unusually severe winter. This is an alternative to the provision of M.G.L., Chapter 44, Section 31D that allows municipalities to overspend snow and ice accounts but obligates them to raise the resulting deficits in the following year's annual tax rate. However, these additional FY87 Lottery funds are not restricted solely for snow and ice removal accounts and may be used for any other municipal purpose.
