RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record requesting the Superintendent of the Water Department and the Chemist for the Water Department to appear before this Council on Monday, May 24, 1976 at 8:00 P. M. to explain the real reason for dirty water, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to prepare suitable guidelines with appropriate fines attached thereto for the future use of hydrants throughout this City.
