WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Legendary Irish Actor, Richard Harris; and

WHEREAS: Richard Harris was a tall, sturdy figure with a reputation as a hellraiser and a lived-in face that he once described as looking like "five miles of bad country road"; and

WHEREAS: Richard Harris came to fame with his roles in such films as "This Sporting Life" and "Camelot" and gained a new generation of fans with his role as the wise old wizard in the two recent Harry Potter movies; and

WHEREAS: One of his most successful movies was "A Man Called Horse", and within the last decade he appeared in two winners of the best picture Oscar – "Unforgiven" in 1992 and Gladiator in 2000; and

WHEREAS: In 1968, Richard Harris had a No. 2 record "Mac Arthur Park", which led to an appearance in the stage production of the rock opera "Tommy"; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Harris was nominated twice for best-actor Academy Awards for his roles in "This Sporting Life" and "The Field", he was also nominated for an Emmy in the 1971 film "The Snow Goose"

WHEREAS: Richard's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his sons, Jared, James, and Damian who have all entered into the business their father cherished; and

WHEREAS: Richard Harris will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
