COUNCILLOR WYLIE

- WHEREAS: Under the revised Zoning Enabling Act and revised Zoning Ordinance the publication of notices of hearings on zoning matters has become the subject of increasingly technical and precise requirements; and
- WHEREAS: The number of zoning petitions for significant actions appears to have increased; and
- WHEREAS: The public interest requires that public hearings be conducted in a timely manner because large numbers of citizens attend such hearings, and for hearings to have been held pursuant to improper notice means that the time of many persons has been wasted; and
- WHEREAS: Property owners deserve the utmost precision in fulfillment of the technical requirements of the zoning act and ordinance; and
- WHEREAS: The Community Development Department employs personnel more trained in the technical aspects of zoning than the City Clerk's office; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Council request that responsibility for the publication of notices of zoning matters be, and it hereby is, transferred from the office of the City Clerk to the Community Development Department.
