In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-nine.

An Ordinance

in addition to "an Ordinance relating to Drains and Common Sewers".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sect. 1. No particular drain shall hereafter be entered into any Main Drain, or common Sewer, constructed or maintained by the City, except by and under the superintendence of the Superintendent of Drains: who shall cause the said entry to be made, upon the request of any person entitled to the same, and at the expense of the party making such request.

Sect. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
