RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council request a traffic study be conducted, by the Department of Traffic and Parking, to determine if it is both feasible and will have a positive impact on the street to make Magee Street into a "one-way" street and that this study be implemented between now and the beginning of March 1991, and the report from this study be completed in time and made available for a mid-March meeting of the Riverside-Cambridgeport Community.
