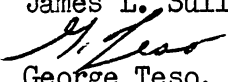

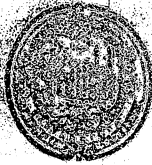
Subject City Council Order No.5 of March 26, 1979 "Resident Parking

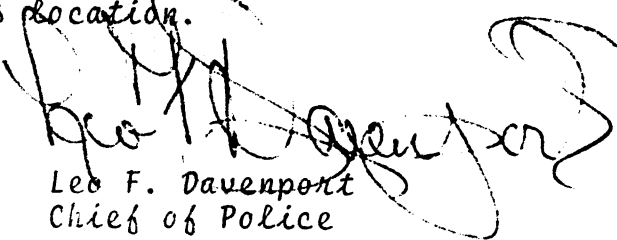

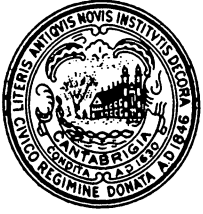
Subject POLICE HAZARDS

The following police hazards are to be checked on each tour of duty:

1. Magoun St.: Cars racing on street, going the wrong way to avoid lights at Mass. & Alewife Brook, especially between 6:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
2. Door 3 Roosevelt Towers: Gangs disturbing residents
3. Porter Road: Enforce resident parking and continue to suppress gang activity
4. Tree land: Check for gangs and disturbances at Memorial and Western Avenue
5. Traffic Enforcement: At end of Gold Star Road and Morrison Court, check for cars blocking area

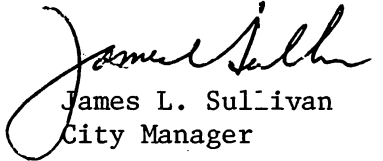
