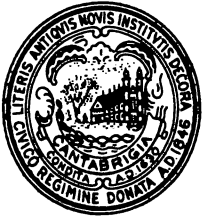

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to inform the City Council that \$245,000.00 is available for appropriation during 1975-76 under contract with the United States Department of Labor. These funds are available through Title X of the Public Works and Economic Development Act to provide job opportunities and related training for unemployed Cambridge residents.

The Cambridge Housing Authority will utilize these monies to augment and expand maintenance projects begun with CETA Title VI funds.

The primary thrust will be two-fold: improvements to the exterior grounds and building surfaces, and improvements to the common interior hallways. It is felt that these changes will not only make the hallways and landscape more attractive and usable, but will also result in substantial reductions in energy requirements and damage due to vandalism.

Passage of this order is recommended.
