Each year on May 31, the World Health Organization and people from its member states celebrate World No Tobacco Day by bringing attention to the harmful effects of tobacco use.

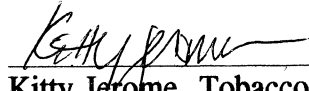
