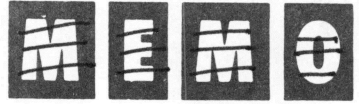
A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. today at Doane, Beal and Ames Funeral Home, 729 Route 134, South Dennis.
