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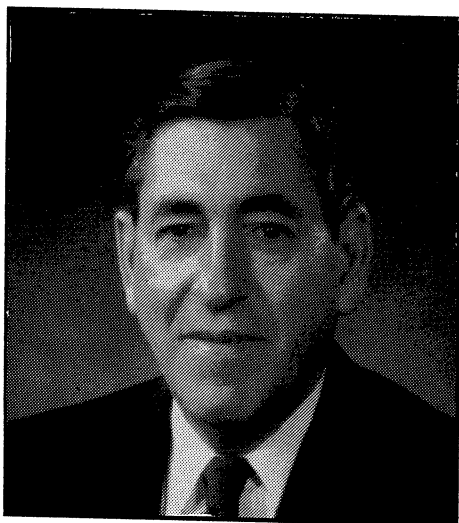

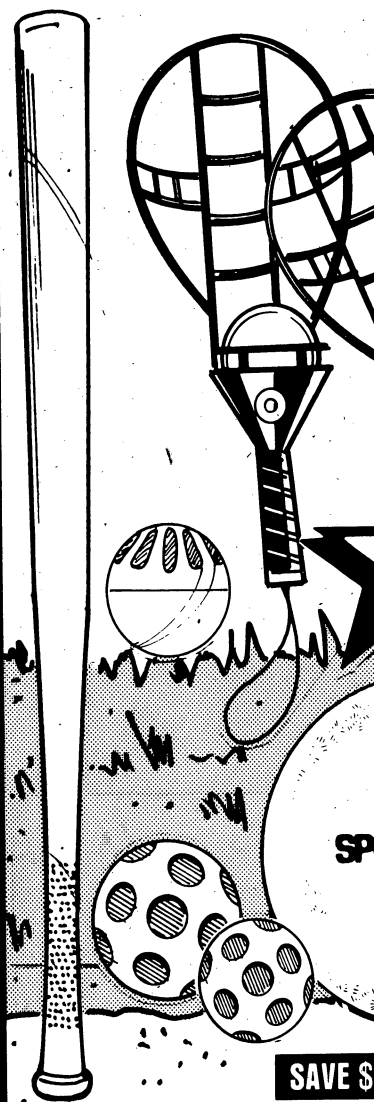
Coop's Argeros to retire

James A. Argeros, President and General Manager of the Harvard Cooperative Society since 1978, has announced plans to retire. Argeros will remain them Coop's chief operating officer until a successor is named.

Under Argeros' leadership, sales at the Coop, America's oldest and largest collegiate bookstore cooperative, increased threefold. In addition, a new MIT store was opened in Kendall Square, the Medical area store was relocated and greatly expanded, and a speciality store was opened in the MIT Stratton Center.

Argeros has said that he plans to utilize the experience and background he has gained in a consulting capacity after leaving the Coop.
