- WHEREAS: The Dean of the Cambridge City Council, Walter J. Sullivan, recently retired from his position as Assistant Clerk Magistrate of the Middlesex County Superior Court completing thirty years of service in Middlesex County in the Commonwealth; and
- WHEREAS: Councillor Sullivan, first elected to the City Council in 1959, for a term beginning 1960 and has been elected in every succeeding election since that time serving the people of Cambridge as Mayor, Chairman of the School Committee in 1968-1969, 1974-1975, 1986-1987; and
- WHEREAS: Walter follows a very proud family tradition of public service which began in 1936 when his late father, Michael, "Mickey the Dude" began his service to the Cambridge City Council and upon his death in 1949 was succeeded the following year by Walter's brother, Edward, who served continuously until 1959 at which time he was succeeded by Walter; and
- WHEREAS: The Sullivan Family has provided the City of Cambridge with fifty-four continuous years of service in the City Council, an unparalleled commitment to constituent service and to the improvement to the quality of life for all its residents; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council, in formal session dated May 21, 1990, go on record extending its heartiest felt appreciation to Councillor Walter J. Sullivan for many contributions to the people of Cambridge and to further wish him well as he is being honored by his many friends and colleagues at a testimonial dinner to be held on June 1, 1990 at the Cambridge Marriott Hotel; and be it further
