At your request I have reviewed the request of the City Electrician for a supplementary appropriation of (\$19,500) in the A-3 Account. In making this review I have had various discussions with Mr. Crocker, and all the employees of the department. In my opinion it is essential to insure the public safety that sufficient funds be appropriated at this time in the A-3 Account.

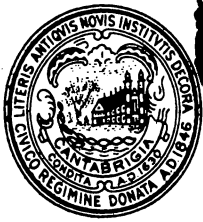
During the past three months there have been various emergencies requiring the overtime services of Electrical Department personnel, which are exceptional in reference to prior years experience, and were not contemplated at the time of budget submission and review. In addition, due to retirements, sick leave and unforeseen accidents there has occurred an unusual work load on the department.

Accordingly, I would agree with Mr. Crocker that at this time a supplementary appropriation of (\$12,000) is necessary and proper.

I would also, submit that in preparing the budget for next year consideration be given to increasing the manpower of the department to satisfy work requirements as a regular basis.


