To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$146,041.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$6,000.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$140,041.00) from the Department of Housing and Community Development. This appropriation represents an increase in this year's Fuel Program award by \$146,041. This additional funding will be used to raise benefit levels by as much as \$60.00 per client. \$19,965 of the award will be used for a special program to be run through and as an extension of the Fuel Program. The program will help Cambridge homeowners eligible in the federal category of poverty with water and sewer bills. Eligible recipients can receive up to \$200 toward annual water and sewer costs.
