WHEREAS: New England Telephone has begun placing pieces of equipment known as Serving Area Interface on the sidewalks of the city; and

WHEREAS: These large and unwieldy structures can be five feet tall and nearly five feet wide and are placed on city sidewalks permanently; and

WHEREAS: The placement of these structures can be a very unsightly obstruction on the sidewalks of the City; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Law Department to draft appropriate legislation severely restricting the size of any permanent structure to be left on the sidewalks of the city; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council with a draft of this legislation in two weeks time.
