ORDERED: That the short segment of Memorial Drive running from the main part of Memorial Drive to Mount Auburn Street in front of the buildings numbered 996, 997, 999, and 1000, be and it hereby is renamed "Mill Hill", its ancient colonial name, so as to enable Cambridge police to patrol parking regulations and the Cambridge Department of Public Works to plow and clear, and so as to reduce confusion on the part of taxi drivers.
