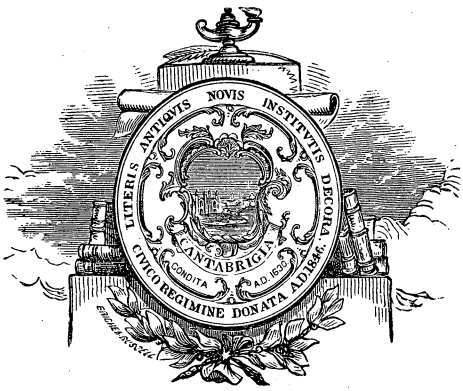




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Surrey Street; so-called
between Putnam Avenue and Banks Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

Forty
feet in width between *said Putnam Avenue*
and Banks Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

W. A. Mason & Son,
Surveyors, dated Sept. 1885

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutters upon said street, having
agreed in writing to waive the usual notice and
to claim no damages for such taking.
