very disgraceful.

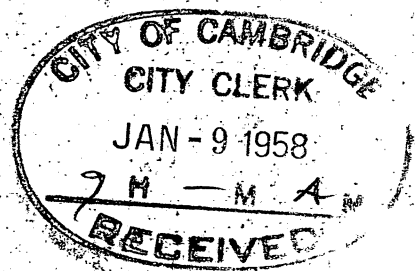

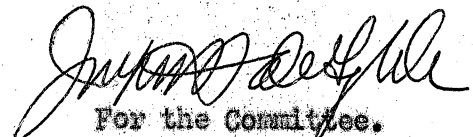
