- WHEREAS: On May 30, 2007, Police Officer Joseph Kelley entered Dunkin Donuts in Central Square and responded to a request by employees to remove a problem individual from the premises; and
- WHEREAS: The individual responded physically to Officer Kelley's attempt to get him to leave and jumped the counter and then ran to the back of the store; and
- WHEREAS: Officer Kelley also jumped over the counter and ran in pursuit. Civilians Nelson Albandoz and Jack Loder followed Officer Kelley to help him; and
- WHEREAS: The disruptive individual ran up the steps to an employees' locker area and threw several items at Officer Kelley and Mr. Albandoz and Jack Loder, who were all standing at the bottom of the stairs; and
- WHEREAS: Officer Kelley and Mr. Albandoz were both struck by a thrown chair, and Mr. Albandoz fell bleeding to the ground; and
- WHEREAS: At this time police backup arrived and the individual was subdued and arrested. Mr. Albandoz was taken to Cambridge Hospital for treatment; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its appreciation for the courage and sense of civil responsibility exhibited by Nelson Albandoz and Jack Loder in attempting to come to the assistance of a police officer in a situation that involved a threat of physical danger; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Nelson Albandoz and Jack Loder.
