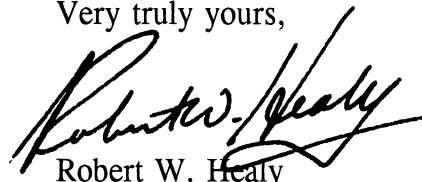
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 21, regarding a report on the Urban Ring Planning meeting, Assistant City Manager for Community Development Susan Schlesinger reports the following:

The MBTA hosted a planning workshop in connection with the Urban Ring Major Investment Study (MIS) on Tuesday, July 15 from Noon to 5 pm at the Egan Center at Northeastern University, which staff of the Community Development Department attended. The topic for the workshop was a discussion of the Urban Ring alignment and technology alternatives which have been generated by the MBTA consultant team.

The workshop was the 3rd in a series of working sessions for the MIS process which provides an opportunity for public agencies, businesses and the general public to participate directly in the Urban Ring planning process. The purpose of the workshops is for the MBTA and its consultant team to both present and solicit information. The workshops are tied to key milestones and decision points in the flow of the MIS technical work. Staff of Community Development will continue to attend and participate in these meetings and will keep the City Council informed of activities.
