To the Honorable, the City Council:

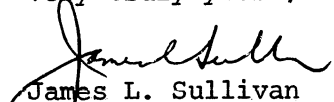
In response to City Council Order No. 3 of January 31, 1977, please be advised that the Traffic and Parking Department has delayed the implementation of the Resident Parking Program due to two reasons.

The first is that the constitutionality of the Resident Parking law has been questioned and arguments were heard by the State Supreme Court on January 3, 1977 and if this law is ruled unconstitutional, we would then have to remove all these signs.

The second reason is that due to the snow cover and frost in the ground, we cannot install any posts to mount these signs.

As soon as the court rules on this law or the weather permits, the posts and the signs will continue to be installed. The Orchard Street Area is scheduled for April 1977.
