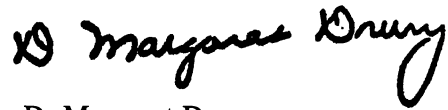

LINDSAY WHITE AIA, VMP

Lindsay White is an architect, project manager, facilitator, and mediator with broad knowledge of the construction, health care, housing and transportation industries. He is currently Senior Construction Architect and Project Manager with Tsoi|Kobus & Associates, Architects.

Mr White was educated at the Harvard Graduate School of Design and Harvard Business School. He has teaching experience at the University of Michigan Medical School, Harvard Business School, The Harvard Graduate School of Design, MIT Sloan School of Management, and Harvard Law School. He trained in negotiation and dispute resolution under Frank Sander and Roger Fisher in the PIL program at Harvard Law School. He trained in project partnering with Ralph Stephenson. He trained in Value Engineering under Tom Snodgrass and Howard Ellegant.

He co-founded and managed for 19 years a 20-person architectural firm with an international reputation for public sector buildings and urban infrastructure. His responsibilities were project management, quality and cost control. A recent example of his work is the lower half of the Fleet Center in Boston, which includes parking, subway tunnel, building services, train station and foundations for the arena and high-rise towers.

In 1993, Mr. White founded The Third Party, a consulting firm dedicated to enhancing team problem solving methods and improving team productivity. The firm facilitated value engineering, partnering, dispute resolution, and construction project risk analysis. It offered courses in various aspects of project management. With The Third Party, his clients were the Massachusetts Port Authority, The Massachusetts Highway Department, GSA, The Government Assistance Program, DPIC Companies, Fidelity Properties, Yellow Freight Systems, Harvard University, and a number of architectural and engineering firms.

Mr. White's mandate at Tsoi|Kobus is to integrate construction with design and establish a program in value management. He is currently also construction architect for the Mormon Temple on Route 2 in Belmont. Tsoi|Kobus & Associates, with Mr. White as manager of quality and cost control, were runners-up in the recent competition for the new Boston Convention Center. He is also on the team proposing to redesign the Fletcher Allen Hospital and University of Vermont Medical School in Burlington, VT.

Mr White is a member of the Society of American Value Engineers and the American Institute of Architects. He is president of the New England Chapter of the Society of American Value Engineers. He is past president and chair of strategic planning of The Guidance Center, Inc. He is a licensed construction supervisor in Massachusetts, and a licensed architect with NCARB certification.
