WHEREAS: Theresa will be sorely missed by all she touched and loved; now therefore be it

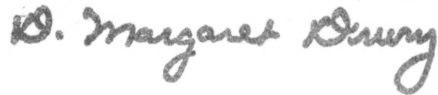
