WHEREAS: Frank N. Cardullo was born in Messina, Italy and started in the food service business as a youngster in Florida, where his father owned a restaurant, meat market and grocery store; and

WHEREAS: Frank purchased the Wursthause Restaurant in Harvard Square in 1942; and

WHEREAS: Under Frank's ownership, he expanded the Wursthause from sixty-four seats to three hundred and ninety-four seats employing eighty-five people, and made it one of the most popular and best-known restaurants in Harvard Square with a menu ranked for several years among the top ten in its category by the National Restaurant Association; and

WHEREAS: In 1950, Frank opened Cardullo's Gourmet Shop, another successful Harvard Square landmark; and

WHEREAS: In addition to his Harvard Square restaurant, shop and catering business, Frank is also president and owner of the Wursthause in Hyannis, Luigi's in Hyannis, Cardullo's in the Prudential Center, Boston, Fran-Rich, Inc. on Prospect Street in Cambridge and Carwich in North Reading; and

WHEREAS: Frank has played an active role in many professional associations in his field of endeavor including the Massachusetts Restaurant Association, of which he was Vice President, the National Restaurant Association, and the Advisory Committee on Food Administration to which he was appointed by Governor John Volpe; and

WHEREAS: In addition to his successful and busy career as a restaurateur and businessman in the food industry, Frank has contributed his talent and energies to a broad range of church and civic affairs; he has chaired several charitable fund drives, including the Red Feather Community Fund, the Heart Fund, the Muscular Dystrophy Drive and the "Coffee Day" Easter Seal Drive; his past and present board and commission membership ranges from Catholic Charities to the Board of Trustees of Boston State College, to the State Group Insurance Commission; and

WHEREAS: Frank has been named "Man of the Year" by various civic organizations, including the Greater Boston Association for Retarded Citizens in 1982, and the National Italian-American Foundation; and

WHEREAS: Frank's energy and hard work have made his restaurant, his shop, and indeed, Frank himself, Harvard Square institutions; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Frank N. Cardullo on behalf of the citizens of Cambridge for his efforts and achievements; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and John F. Kennedy Street is hereby designated "Frank Cardullo Corner;" and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk prepare an engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Frank Cardullo at a ceremony for the dedication of "Frank Cardullo Corner."
