COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: People of the Jewish faith throughout the world, starting at sundown on Wednesday, April 11, 1979, will begin the traditional eight day festival of freedom called Passover; and
- WHEREAS: Passover will begin with a two day religious festival banquet called Sedar; and
- WHEREAS: This eight day period of religious observance commemorates the exodus of Jewish people from slavery in Egypt approximately 3800 years ago; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council, on behalf of all the people of Cambridge, whatever their faith may be, joins in wishing our Jewish neighbors a "Good Yontiff"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Rabbi and Congregation of Temple Beth Shalom as they begin the holy observance of Passover.
