RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge does hereby recognize Saturday, June 8, 1991 as the official Cambridge Lesbian, Gay, and Bisexual Pride Day, and urges the citizens of Cambridge to recognize this very special tribute by joining in the activities of the day; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation.
