ORDERED:

That in the event that the Legislature and/or the Senate does not enact an extension of Chapter 842 of the Acts of 1970 and Chapter 842 expires on March 31, 1976, and the City of Cambridge is unable to obtain Home Rule Rent Control at the expiration of Rent Control on March 31, 1976, that the City Manager be requested to direct the Director of Rent Control to keep the Rent Control Office opened with full complement of staff to cope with any and all problems that could arise from the possible failure of extending Chapter 842, and from any unpreparedness of the City to have passed a Home Rule Act; "Stitch In Time Saves Nine".
