- WHEREAS: Firefighter Spindler was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on May 7, 1972 and was transferred to Ladder Two an assignment from which he will retire, and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Spindler will be greatly missed by his fellow firefighters for his leadership and friendliness, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere appreciation and gratitude to Lieutenant George H. Spindler for his twenty-seven years of dedicated fire service and to extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
