

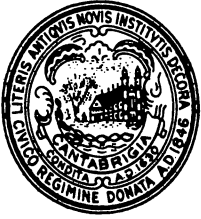



To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am resubmitting herewith the request for an appropriation of \$100,000 to the Traffic and Parking Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account, which will enable the City to increase the number of parking summonses from 1,200 to 2,000 per day. This increase in workload will result in increased mailing, printing and computer costs. It is important that this appropriation be approved at this meeting in order that the City may continue to catch up on the backlog of overdue parking fines, thereby increasing revenues to the Parking Fund.

Passage of this appropriation, which will be funded from the Parking Fund, is strongly recommended.
