- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that on Saturday, August 18, 1984, American Legion Post #442 will install Cambridge Police Officer Thomas E. Donahue as its new Commander; and
- WHEREAS: Commander Donahue, a Cambridge native, attended local public schools and later served in the United States Army in Korea, as a member of the 82nd Airborne Division as a Paratrooper, and upon being honorably discharged, worked for a time for the Metropolitan District Commission and later was appointed to the Cambridge Police Department, a position he has held for nearly twelve years; and
- WHEREAS: Commander Donahue has long been active in civic and veteran affairs, serving on several "Post" committees and as a member of the Color Guard; and
- WHEREAS: It is widely acknowledged throughout Cambridge that Tom Donahue is the Police Department's version of "Paul Harvey", since he is a familiar voice over the police radio, dispatching cars and emergency personnel daily; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its best wishes and congratulations to Thomas E. Donahue as he is installed as the new Commander of Post #442, and to all the new officers as they assume their new responsibilities; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Commander on behalf of the entire City Council.
