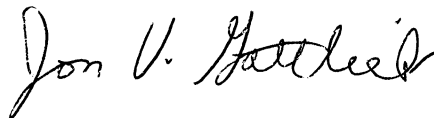
Dear Mayor Reeves and Council Members,
