To the Honorable

the Mayor, Aldermen & Common Council

the laying down of flagging stones for making a
suitable walk from the sidewalk, at the corner of
the Brattle house lot on Brattle St. across said Brattle
Square to the sidewalk on the easterly side of Mount
Auburn Street, and also across said Brighton & Dunster
Streets in the line of said sidewalk.
