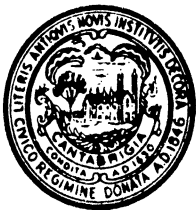

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$4,000 from the Reserve Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The funds will help support the Cambridge Community Chorus. The Cambridge Community Chorus' 10<sup>th</sup> Annual performance of the *Messiah* is scheduled for December 12<sup>th</sup> at the Kresge Auditorium. In addition to the annual performance of the *Messiah*, the Cambridge Community Chorus presents both a fall and spring concert each year. The Chorus also sings each year at the Joyful Noise celebration of Martin Luther King Jr.'s birthday and at the Cambridge Holocaust Remembrance.

The chorus also offers a Choral Scholars program for four CRLS students (soprano, alto, tenor and bass) chosen by auditions. These students each receive \$100 and special vocal training and master classes in singing.
