To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$5,282.00 into the Grant fund of Department of Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$5,090) and Travel and Training Account (\$192) from the Cambridge/Somerville Low Heating Assistance Program. The City of Cambridge operates the Cambridge/Somerville Fuel Assistance Program which services approximately 4,000 residents of both cities. The Massachusetts Bureau of Energy programs is releasing administrative funds which are to be used for FY94 close out and start up for FY95 (The program year runs from October 1 through September 30). These supplemental funds were allocated as a result of state wide increases in costs due to the bad winter of 1994.
