To the Honorable, the City Council:

I take this occasion to comment on several orders emanating from the January 28th Council Meeting.

Please be advised that in response to Council Order No. 2, the Public Works Commissioner has surveyed the pre-school shelter location on Rindge Avenue and remedial work has been authorized to solve the problems existing at that location. The work will commence as soon as the necessary material arrives and this is momentarily expected.

City Council Order No. 3 requests the appointment of an Equal Opportunity Employment Officer for the City of Cambridge and I am designating Mr. Robert J. LeBlanc, the Acting Personnel Director, to assume this responsibility.

City Council Order No. 4 refers to hazardous and unsanitary problems on Plympton Street. I wish to advise your Honorable Body that the Public Works Commissioner is reviewing the problems cited at this location and also those cited at the corner of Green and Bay Streets, referred to in City Council Order No. 5 of the same date.

As far as Council Order No. 6 is concerned, which refers to negotiations with the Police Patrolmen's Association, I wish to advise your Honorable Body that I am communicating with, and have met with, the Police Association concerning their contract. I shall continue my negotiations with this group and shall keep your Honorable Body advised.
